Pilgrimage to Lourdes

In 2019 the Pilgrimage to Lourdes will be led by Bishop Philip assisted in many aspects by young people from throughout the Diocese who will lead music, catechesis, social activities, help pilgrims with their mobility by offering a steadying hand or pushing a wheelchair. All pilgrims will stay at the Hotel La Solitude (bedrooms are air-conditioned, and there is a swimming pool) which is quite close to the Shrine on a full board basis. Young pilgrims (those that will be assisting when in Lourdes) will travel there by overnight coach. All other pilgrims will travel by plane, flying from Southampton airport.
